Class 1	Five stems of Daffodil/Narcissus (can be any mixture)
Class 2	Specimen Daffodil/Narcissus
Class 3	Winter Flowering Pansies or Violas - 3 stems **
Class 4	A bulb in flower growing in a container (NOT Daffodil/Narcissus)*
Class 5	Container of Bulbs in flower* (with no other planted material)
Class 6	Vase of Mixed Garden Flowers
Class 7	Miniature Flower Arrangement (max. 10 x 10 cm)
Class 8	Camellia flower floating in a glass or glass dish
Class 9	Hellebore - 3 flowers floating in a dish
Class 10	A flowering or foliage house plant *

Society vases must be used for classes 1, 2 & 6

Only one entry per household or allotment is permitted for each class except for Class 7.

The Hall opens at 6.00 pm for members to bring entries. Registration takes place then – and there is no fee to enter.

Exhibits must be in place for judging by 7.00 pm.

[#] Pansies & Violas should be displayed flat with short stems inserted through a card or board

^{*} Must have been in exhibitor's possession for at least 3 months Entries for classes 1, 2, 3, 6, 8 and 9 must have been grown in the member's own garden and/or allotment.
